



# Math with Dice OR Deck of Cards

**War-** (comparing numbers) Add extra practice by putting the sign between cards.  
Ex:  $7 > 2$ ,  $7 < 9$ ,  $7 = 7$

**Tally-** Flip a card or roll dice and make that many tally marks

**Equations-** Flip 2 cards and add or subtract the numbers-write the math equations

**Related facts-** Flip 2 cards, Make related facts. Ex:  $8 + 3 = 11$ ,  $3 + 8 = 11$ ,  $11 - 3 = 8$ ,  $11 - 8 = 3$

**10 More-** Roll dice or draw a card. Figure out what ten more is.

**Tens and Ones-** Roll 2 dice. If you roll a 5 and 2, Make 5 tens and 2 ones. Your number is 52.

**Adding 2 Digit Numbers Using Tens and Ones-** Roll 2 dice, if you roll a 5 and 2 your number is 52. Make 5 tens and 2 ones then roll the 2 dice again if you roll a 3 and 9 your number is 39. Make 3 tens and 9 ones. Now figure out the sum by adding tens together and your ones together.
